Are power banks allowed on AirAsia?

Power banks are prohibited from charging other portable electronic devices throughout the flight. Power banks are prohibited in checked-in baggage and must be carried in the cabin. To ensure compliance, AirAsia will display safety reminders at check-in counters, and reinforce the policy through boarding and in-flight announcements.

Are power banks allowed on Singapore Airlines?

Starting 1 April 2025, Singapore Airlines passengers will be prohibited from charging portable power banks via onboard USB ports or using them to charge personal devices during the entire flight, in accordance with IATA regulations. Power banks must be carried in cabin baggage on all SIA flights and are not allowed in checked baggage.

Can I bring a power bank on a SIA flight?

Power banks must be carried in cabin baggage on all SIA flights and are not allowed in checked baggage. Passengers can bring power banks with a capacity of up to 100 Wh without needing special approval. However, power banks between 100 Wh and 160 Wh require prior airline approval. This policy also applies to Scoot.

Can you carry a power bank on Malaysia Airlines?

Malaysia Airlines: Passengers must carry their power banks with them at all times. Power banks are not to be placed in the overhead compartments, but may be stored in a passenger's carry-on item placed under the seat in front of them or in the seat-back pockets in front of them. Power banks may not be used or charged during the flight.
