Do solar panels affect property taxes?

When you install solar panels on your property, it can potentially affect your property taxes. However, the extent of the impact depends on the state you live in and its tax laws. Does the solar tax credit affect property taxes?

No. The 30% federal solar tax credit only reduces your federal income taxes. It has no direct impact on your property tax bills, which are decided by state/local policies. If I lease solar panels, do I still get the property tax exemption? - Yes.
