

What are the Juba mobile base station sites

The first airfield in Juba was cleared in 1929. The Shell Company constructed the first runway in 1931. It was surfaced with crushed laterite. In February 1931, Imperial Airways opened the first 2,670 miles of the weekly Croydon to Tanganyika Territory (now part of Tanzania) portion of the Cape to Cairo air-route, and established a mooring place near Rejaf to the south of Juba, for Imperial Airways' Calcutta flying-bo...

UN House is one of the two bases of the United Nations Mission in South Sudan (UNMISS) in Juba. It has been constructed since 2011 as a replacement to the mission's initial base near the airport, which is still functioning.

As of May 2011, Juba International Airport was undergoing improvements and expansion. The work on the airport included expansion of the passenger and cargo terminal buildings, resurfacing of the runway and installation ...

The city features several notable landmarks, including the All Saints Cathedral, built in 1972, and the Juba Bridge, which connects the city across the White Nile.
