Can I store items in my elevator machine room? No. Machine rooms should be strictly reserved for elevator-related equipment. Storing unrelated items can pose fire hazards, impede maintenance, and ...

Wheeled items that are in-use, such as mobile computer on wheels, linen and housekeeping carts can be in the egress access corridor, if these are moved within 30-minutes.

Storage areas shall be kept free from accumulation of materials that constitute hazards from tripping, fire, explosion, or pest harborage. Vegetation control will be exercised when necessary.
